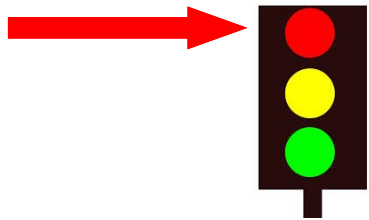

Is this course for me?

This course is for you if you are:

- a class teacher who has students with dyslexia and knows very little about what that means
- a newly qualified teacher
- any other adult working with people with dyslexia
- a parent of a child with dyslexia
- a governor of a school
- an employer
- a person with an interest in dyslexia

Content

You will learn:

- how dyslexia affects reading, spelling, writing, memory and organisation
- what it feels like to be dyslexic
- what simple changes can be made to remove barriers to full participation for people with dyslexia.
