## What is CCET & AAC?

The Certificate of Competence in Educational Testing (CCET) will enable the participant to confidently understand the principles involved in educational testing and carry out that testing themselves.

A successful completion of the CCET will lead to the British Psychological Society Test User Educational qualification (*optional additional registration fee & annual subscription to BPS is not included in the course fees*).

It will enable the participant to undertake the additional Access Arrangements Course (AAC) to become an access arrangements assessor as defined by JCQ regulations and required from Sept 2017.

## CCET content

- understand the purposes of testing & assessment
- become familiar with theories about testing & psychometrics
- understand the legislative and policy framework
- select, evaluate, administer and interpret different types of educational tests
- carry out an assessment of a learner and report the findings

CCET is an intensive, three full days course to be held at Taverham High School from **10-12 July 2017**.

Some additional online work will be required.

AAC— One full day course— Autumn term date TBC -to run in conjunction with the CCET.
