Literacy Programmes

Beat Dyslexia (Books 1-6) - A multisensory structured literacy programme

Sound Discovery — A synthetic phonics literacy programme for the teaching of reading, spelling and writing

Read, Write, Inc Fresh Start (Modules 1-5) - A programme providing a cohesive and creative approach to teaching children to read and write

PAT - Phonological Awareness Training (Beginners, Level 1-3) - Designed to increase phonological awareness skills. May work well with pupils struggling with the memory demands of synthetic phonics blending.

Launch into Reading Success through Phonological Awareness Training - aimed at but not limited to Y1 pupils at risk of reading delay. Programme to develop phonological awareness skills.
